Security	Per NPP - three hours after event on weekends; two hours on weekdays	Depends on event
Occupancy	Legal capacity occupancy limit	No more than 25 events per year with capacity greater than 1,000 if amplified sound .
Outdoor amplified sound (above level of human conversation as heard on Racine)	Must end by 10 p.m. weekdays; 11 p.m. Friday and Saturday	No more than 25 events per year ; Must end by 10 p.m. weekdays; 11 p.m. Friday and Saturday
